

HOUSE RULES

I find it helpful if parents and their children know and understand the “HOUSE RULES” in my child care. I make an effort to direct children’s behavior by making positive statements about what they can do. I save “No!”, “Don’t!” and “Stop!” for times of danger. These are some of my House Rules.

1. Showing care and respect for one another at all times.
2. Respecting one another’s property.
3. Activities such as running and jumping will take place outside.
4. Use an inside speaking voice when inside.
5. Throwing objects will take place outside (under supervision).
6. Pick up items after play (not leaving small pieces for babies and toddlers to find).
7. Watch for fingers when opening and closing doors.
8. Wash hands before eating and after using the toilet.
9. Eat while sitting down.
